



Instructions for Wire Payments to Canadian Imperial Bank of Commerce (CIBC) from Remitters Worldwide in all Currencies

Instructions To send a wire payment from anywhere in the world in any currency, the remitter should provide the following information to their financial institution.

Required Information Pay By SWIFT MT103 to CIBC Toronto, CIBCCATT

Fields **57** and **59** must be completed as shown:

If your financial institution does not have a relationship with CIBC, please have them direct the payment through SWIFT Code XXXXXXXX (see table below).
